#### GUEST LECTURE ON "SAY NO TO PLASTIC"

Addressing an attentive audience, he underscored the need for immediate action by stating, "Plastic may seem like a convenience, but it's a burden our planet can no longer bear. Each one of us has the power to make a difference by adopting sustainable habits."

The lecture highlighted the devastating impact of single-use plastics on ecosystems and the urgency to transition towards greener alternatives. Mr. Singh advocated for minimising the use of plastic and increasing the use of eco-friendly bioplastics, which can decompose. Students were actively engaged, with many pledging to avoid plastic in their daily lives.
